

2023 City Visit to Trinity House (Independent travel to London)

Monday 24 April 2023 at 11am at Trinity House

Join us on a visit to Trinity House, which overlooks the Tower of London and Tower Bridge. Trinity House is a splendid late 18th century grade 1 Georgian building in Trinity Square, near to Tower Hill tube station. It is dedicated to safeguarding shipping and seafarers, most especially the country's lighthouses.



We start with coffee and biscuits and have our first guided tour of the house in the morning. Badly damaged during WW11, the house was restored to its 18th century glory, adhering to photographs of the original. It is primarily the artefacts and history, and City of London qualified guides' knowledge and enthusiasm which make this particular tour so special. If you love history and art, the exhibits will take you through key points in our maritime history.

Following lunch at your own expense we will do a second tour at 2pm from Trinity House called "Sailors, Saints and Samuel Pepys". This will be led by a City of London guide.
