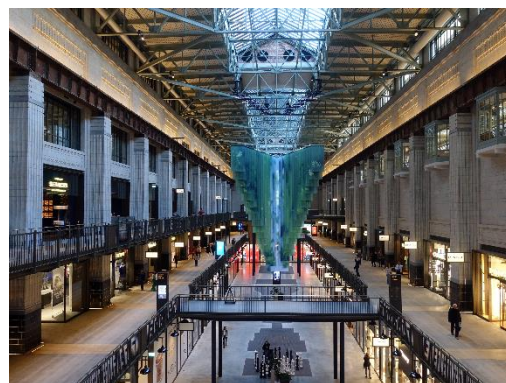




A Morning Walk around Battersea Power Station with Ian Swankie

Thursday, 3 October 2024

Battersea Power Station has been totally transformed in recent years and we have arranged for a conducted tour with Ian Swankie on Thursday 3 October.

We will travel independently, and propose taking the 09.40 train from Leatherhead (09.43 at Ashted) to Vauxhall Station. Then we travel by bus for the 6 minute journey to Battersea Power Station (bring your Bus Pass).

We will gather at 11.15 for a briefing by Ian and collection of the Individual Audio Guide equipment. The walking tour will start at 11.30 and last for about 90 minutes.

On this walk we'll see the glitzy new apartment blocks by well-known architects including Norman Foster and Frank Gehry, then we'll explore the power station building both outside and in.

After the tour you can have lunch in one of the many restaurants and cafes inside the building and could also book a trip up Lift109 (at your own expense) – the very top of one of the chimneys.

The cost will be £18 a head (inclusive of guide and headsets) and the visit is limited to 24 members (TASLEA only)
