Under the expert guidance of Kate Davey, an accredited Blue Badge Guide and a member of Inner Temple, this visit will take us to the Inns of Court and the Royal Courts of Justice.

Our visit will start in The Garden Room, with refreshments, followed by a 90 minute tour.

We will visit the [Temple Church](#) with its many historic associations including the negotiation of the Magna Carta between 1214 and 1219, and the American Declaration of Independence and Constitution . The Temple was the birthplace of American Law.



We will then have a buffet lunch in Middle Temple Hall alongside barristers and judges. Built in 1562 with a hammer beam roof. Shakespeare and Elizabeth I both knew this Hall. Although our access will be pre-booked, but we each buy our own food and drink.

In the afternoon Kate will lead us to the [Royal Courts of Justice](#), which are open to visitors after we have been through the security check.

We will then visit Gray's Inn and Lincoln's Inn. Like the Temple, these are tranquil areas of London, with plenty of history and beautiful buildings.

Cost: The price of £33 covers tea/coffee on arrival, the Society's payment to our Guide, Kate Davey and entry to Temple Church.

We will each pay for our own travel, and lunch.
