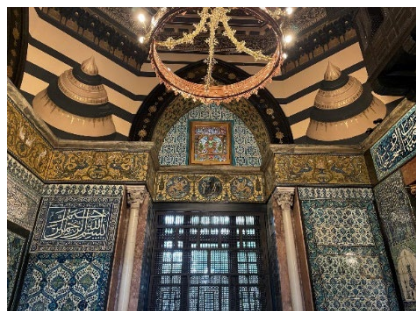


Guided Tour of Leighton House and Sambourne House Holland Park, London W14 Monday 9 September 2024

As a complementary visit to our April lecture 'A Private Palace of Art – Frederic Leighton's Studio House', we have planned an outing to Leighton House in Holland Park and a visit to the nearby Sambourne House.

Both houses are the extraordinary legacies left by two 'celebrities' of the late Victorian era: Frederic Lord Leighton, painter and president of the Royal Academy of Arts and Edward Linley Sambourne, Chief Cartoonist at the infamous satirical magazine Punch. Whereas Leighton's studio-house was designed and built to his specific requirements, Sambourne House was an adaptation of a conventional late-Victorian terraced house.

We will travel by train to Kensington Olympia, changing at Clapham Junction. Leighton House is a 10-minute walk from the station and we will stop for coffee on the way. After the Leighton House tour, there are various options for lunch en route to Sambourne House, an 8-minute walk away.

Cost: The joint tour cost is **£38**, which includes admission and guided tours in each house. Each tour takes approximately an hour and a half.

Accessibility: Sambourne House has no step-free access, with 8 external steps to the basement visitor reception and stairs to all four internal floors. Leighton House has a lift and step-free access.
